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Anglo Arabic Model School

The Anglo Arabic Model School is a co-educational Self Financing, English medium institution. The school emerged as a new chapter in the year 1996 and was finally recognised in the year 2009. One of the key objectives of the Society and its schools is to create an enabling environment conducive for education and to realize the rights of the children

The Anglo Arabic Model School is the latest addition to the longest running educational complex in Delhi located just outside the Ajmeri Gate. The complex stands on a site that has a rich political history dating back over 300 years. The school emerged as a new chapter in the evolving story of this site. To understand the context in which the Anglo Arabic Model School was created, we must go back to the era of the Mughal emperor Aurangzeb. Ghazi ud-Din Khan Feroze Jung I, a general in Aurangzeb's army, established a madrasa and a mosque at this place in the 1690s. It was named after him, the Madrasa Ghazi ud-Din Khan. With the decline of Aurangzeb's reign, the madrasa closed between 1790 and 1791. After his death, Ghazi ud-Din Khan was buried on the site and his tomb still exists today .

Since its establishment in 1996, the Anglo Arabic Model School has grown more than ten times in terms of student enrollment, has added classes VIII through Xth and has been recognized by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in 2012.



The story of the school is a centuries old, fascinating tale of shifting political power structures, the need to serve the Muslim minority community and a desire to provide modern education in English. The school is a minority institution but places no restriction on who may enroll. At the Anglo Arabic Model School, we hope to continue this legacy and serve the community without prejudice or partiality and help build an educated, modern and just society that is self-reliant and imaginative while being connected to its rich cultural heritage.

Activity Details

The details of activities undertaken in the field of Scholastic and Co-Scholastic are given hereunder as:

Scholastic Activities:

1. Scholastic content on English, Hindi, Urdu, Maths, Science, Social Science and IT/Computer subjects , are being provided on the assigned WhatsApp groups of each class .The content carries handwritten notes, YouTube links to the prescribed NCERT syllabus, E-Pathshala etc.
2. Guidance is also being provided to the parents to down load the Diksha App from the play store & App store for their children.
3. Zoom meeting application also uploaded for online video conference classes
4. In order to enhance the reading, writing, creative & speaking skill of students of all classes, worksheets are provided to them by concerned subject teacher

5. Voice notes, videos & interactive voice response activities are being provided to the students so that students can complete their assignment given to them while playing and learning with the indolent of their parents and siblings.

6. Due to non-availability of new note books in the market, children are advised to carry out the assigned work in unused sheets of old notebooks. This way children are also learning use of optimum resources.

7. The Teachers are also in regular touch with both parents and students on telephone so that they can clear their doubts if any arises, during the course of online teaching-learning process .

Co-Scholastic activities

1. Children are being advised to start the day with Dua/ Prayer to make the atmosphere more conducive/ soothing for them. Prayer Video, Devotional songs, Desh Bhakti Geet , basic of sargam etc are also being provided regularly to the students in order to reduce their stress.

2. Study material on Self-Introduction, Toys Conversation, video on phonic sounds, the concept of Healthy habits for healthy kids, role-play. Let's talk about our daily routine, self-motivational tips with self-learning process are being provided to the students for their easy learning of English conversation and Health education.

3. Group discussion through zoom meetings are also being organized on topic "COVID-19 Causes, Origin, Symptoms, Precautions and Prevention" for greater awareness on corona virus.

4. Since Healthy mind lives in healthy body therefore online education also being given to the students to keep them fit both physically and mentally during lockdown/ quarantine. Education through audio/video provided on Yoga , meditation ,Exercise (Warming, Physical & Breathing) and various Indoor games.

5. Since essence of education lies in bringing out the hidden talent of students to enrich the creative thinking skills of students.
